Aggie Football and Volleyball Travel Procedures

- Football and volleyball teams will travel on school buses sitting assigned by a seating chart.
- All players, coaches, band members, and chaperones must wear face masks while on the bus.
- Teams will travel in uniform and not change at the host stadium/gymnasium
- Cheerleaders will travel if there is a designated place for them to cheer. Cheerleaders will not be allowed to cheer on the football field.
- The band will travel based on spacing and rules of the other teams' stadium.

Aggie Football Home Game Procedures

Pre-Game

- Tickets for 50% of the stadium capacity will be sold. For the home side, 1600 tickets will be sold and 800 tickets for the visitors side will be sold.
- All tickets will be pre-sold. Tickets will be sold at Indian Valley Elementary, Pinecrest Elementary, Nichols Middle School, Sylacauga High School and the Sylacauga Chamber of Commerce. The price of each ticket will be \$7.00. No tickets will be sold at the gate.
- Face masks must be worn when entering and exiting the stadium, and when moving about at the stadium.
- Signage will be posted reminding fans to social distance and sanitize. The temperature of each person will be taken before entering the stadium.
- Coaches or staff from visiting teams will not be allowed to use the home press boxes.
- Football boosters will be allowed to sell merchandise outside the stadium until the game starts.

- Only prepackaged items will be sold in the concession stand.
- The Aggie Marching Band will be allowed on the field during pre-game abiding by the social distancing guidelines. The band will enter and exit the stadium through the 6th Street entrance.
- Cheerleaders will be allowed on the field during pre-game to hold the breakthrough sign and run the team onto the field. Cheerleaders will be required to wear masks at all times while on the fields and performing stunts. Cheerleaders will not be required to wear masks when cheering on the sidelines and socially distanced.
- Two Key Club Members will be allowed on the field to raise the flag.
- Only one team captain will be allowed on the field for the coin toss.

During the Game

- Family members will be allowed to sit together. All families will be encouraged to social distance.
- Face masks must be worn when entering and exiting the stadium, and when moving about at the stadium.
- Cheerleaders will do touchdown push ups from the endzone if this tradition is continued.
- Cheerleaders will not host visiting cheerleaders during halftime.
- Only the football players, coaches, and officials will be allowed on the field.
- Two band students and the band director will be responsible for lowering the flag at the end of the third quarter.

After the Game

- After the game, the alma mater will be played from the stands. No students, parents, or cheerleaders will be allowed on the field.
- Football players will not shake the hands of the opposing team.
- Football players will exit the locker room through the weight room into the parking lot rather than coming back into the stadium to greet family and friends.
- Families should exit the stadium immediately after the game and meet their players in the field house parking lot.
- Locker rooms will be cleaned and sanitized.

Aggie Volleyball Home Game Procedures

- Tickets for 50% of the gymnasium capacity will be sold. For the competition gym, 500 tickets will be sold and 150 for the old gym will be sold.
- Face masks must be worn when entering and exiting the gym, and when moving about in the gym or foyer.
- Signs will be posted reminding fans to social distance and the temperature of everyone will be taken before entering the gymnasium.
- Only prepackaged items will be sold in the concession stand.
- Locker rooms will be cleaned and sanitized after each match.
- Volleyball team will not participate in tournaments that include more than ten teams.

At this time, there are no other restrictions.
